The Atlanta Area Council offers nine National Youth Leadership Training Courses (NYLT) at Bert Adams Scout Camp. NYLT is a National program that is delivered at the Council level. These courses are open to both Scouts and Venturers. Six of these courses were held this summer in June, with three courses to finish out the year in November and December. So far over 200 youth have successfully completed the training this summer.

The purpose of NYLT is to support unit leaders in training their youth. This demanding week-long course features instruction in skills that can be used at home, at school, on the job, and, in particular, at the Scout unit level. Through activities, events, games and adventures, NYLT participants work hard and play hard together as they put into action the best that Scouting has to offer.
