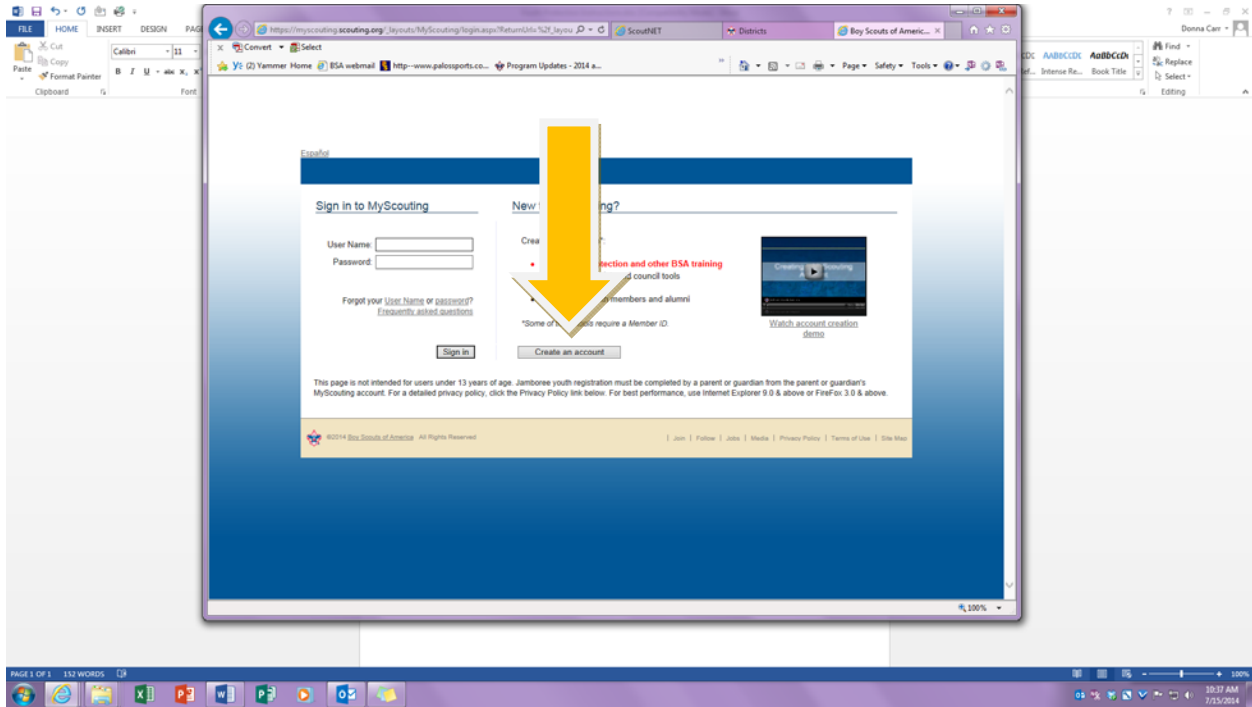
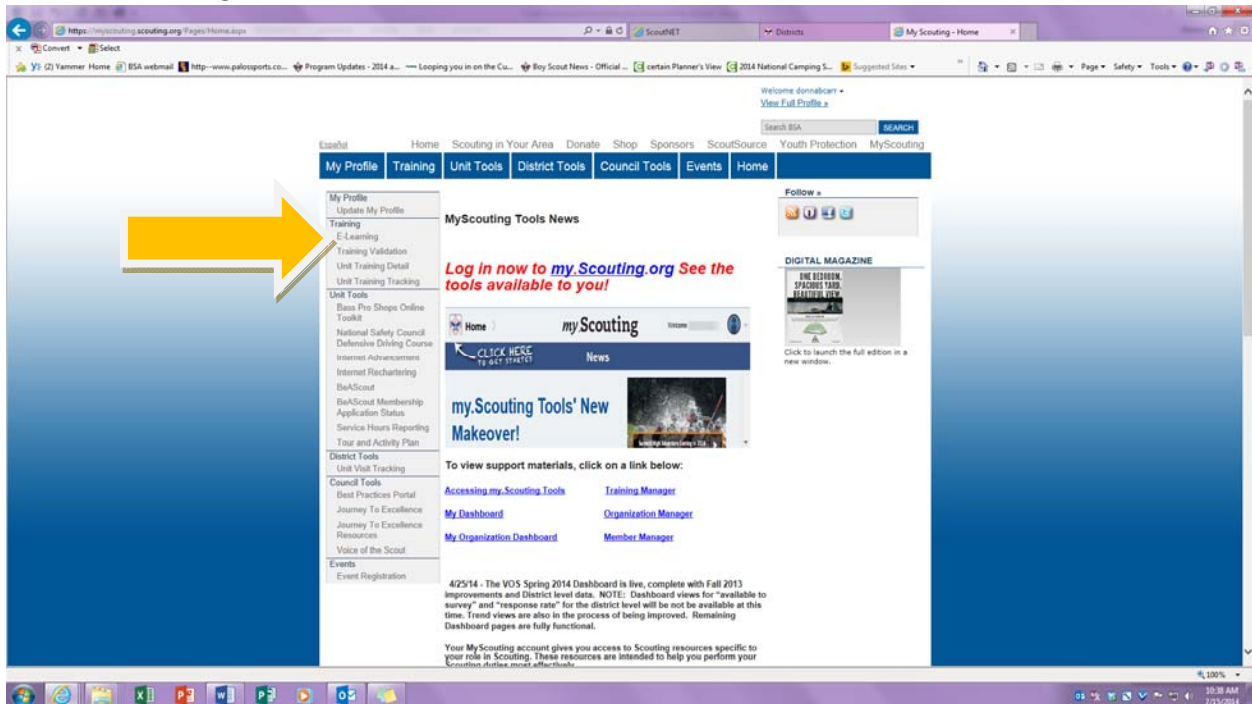


ON-LINE YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING INSTRUCTIONS

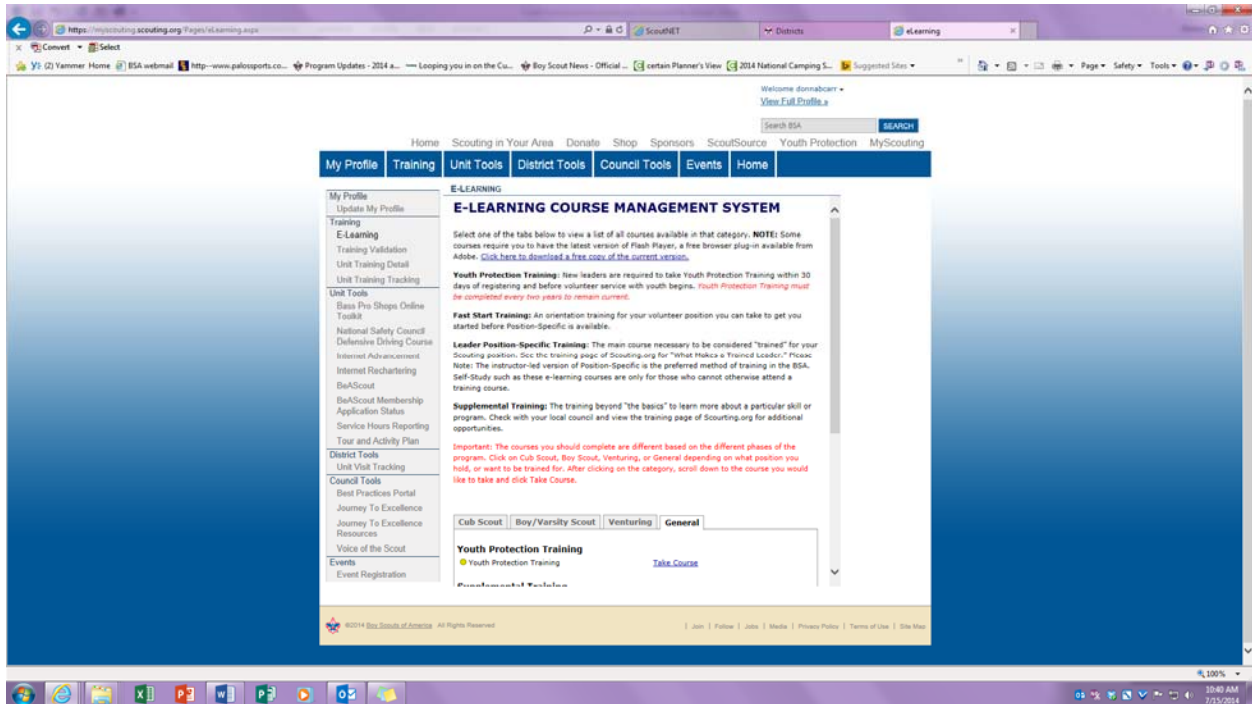
Please go to www.myscouting.org, set up an account if necessary.



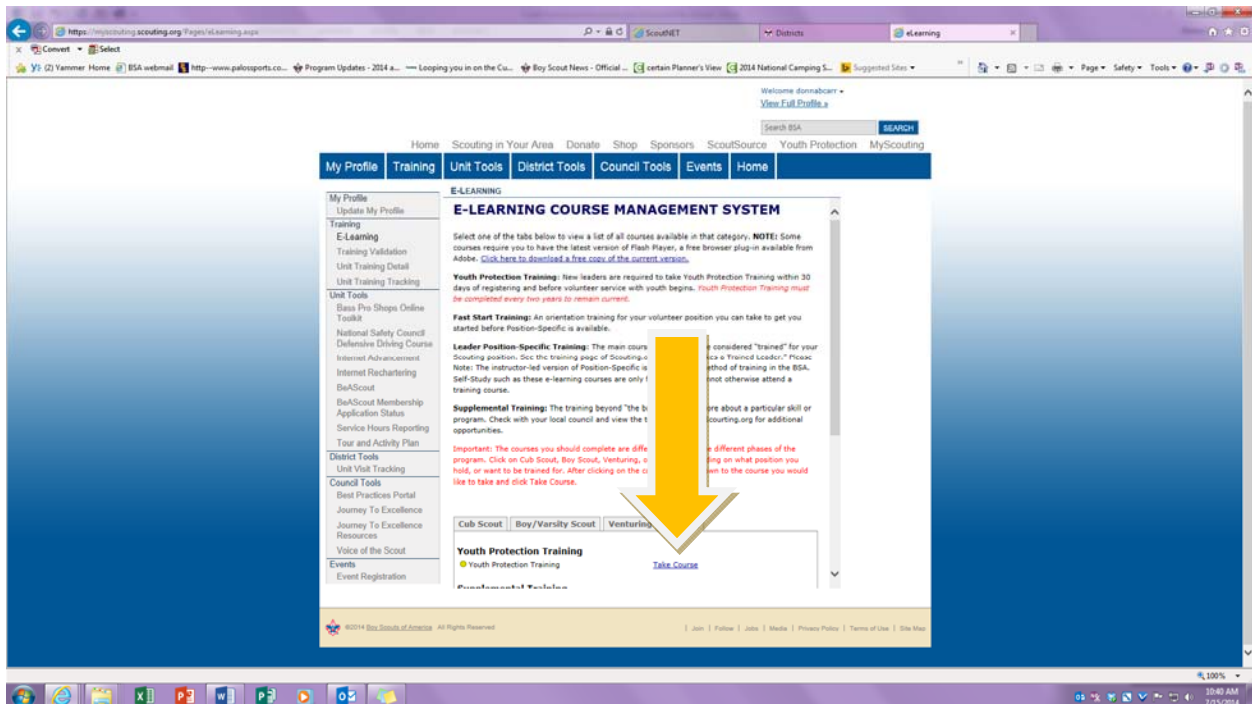
Click on **E-Learning**



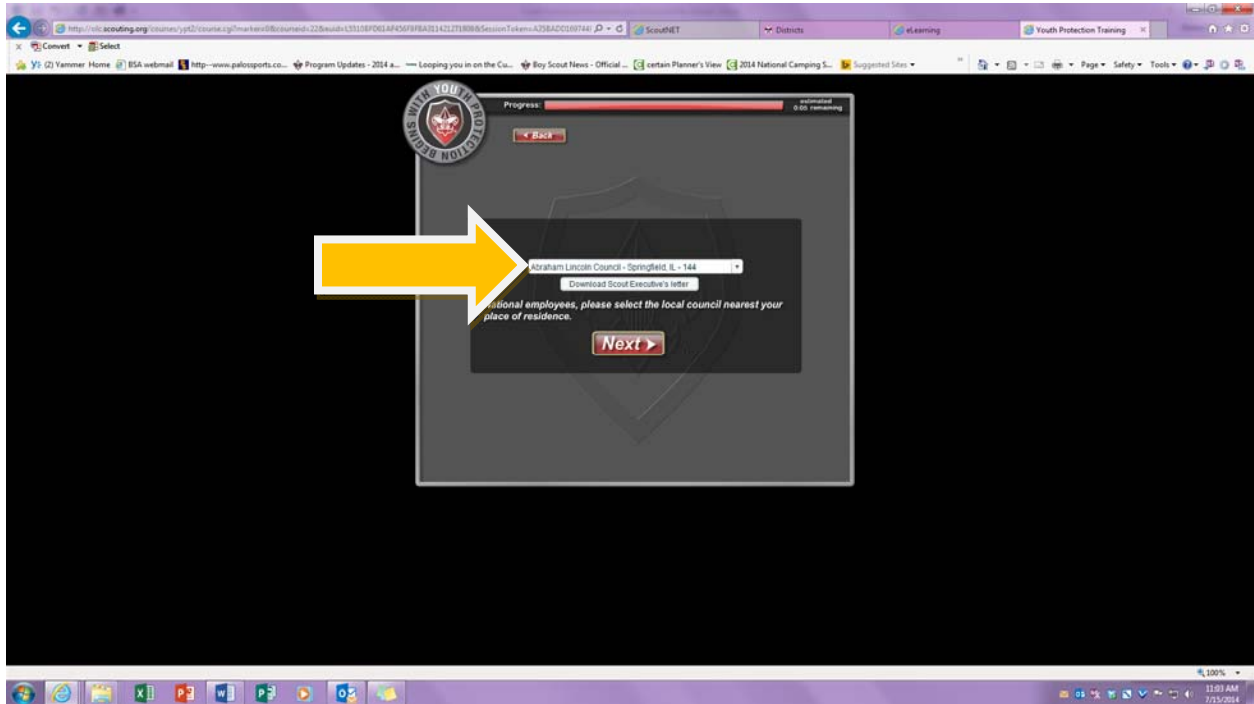
Scroll Down to the bottom of the **E-LEARNING COURSE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM** screen, click on the **General Tab** (If you are a Venturing Leader, click on the **Venturing** tab)



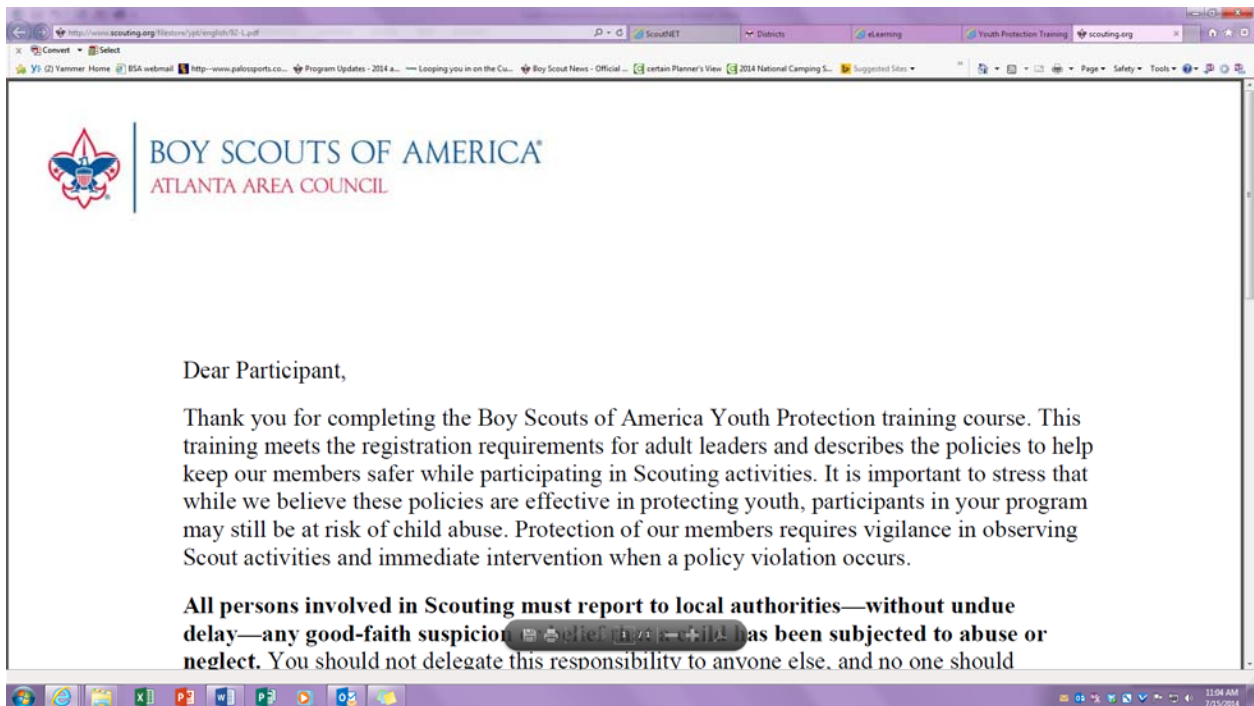
Click on the **Take Course** button beside **Youth Protection Training** and begin! Please allow approximately 30 minutes to complete the course. You may put it on hold and continue later if necessary.



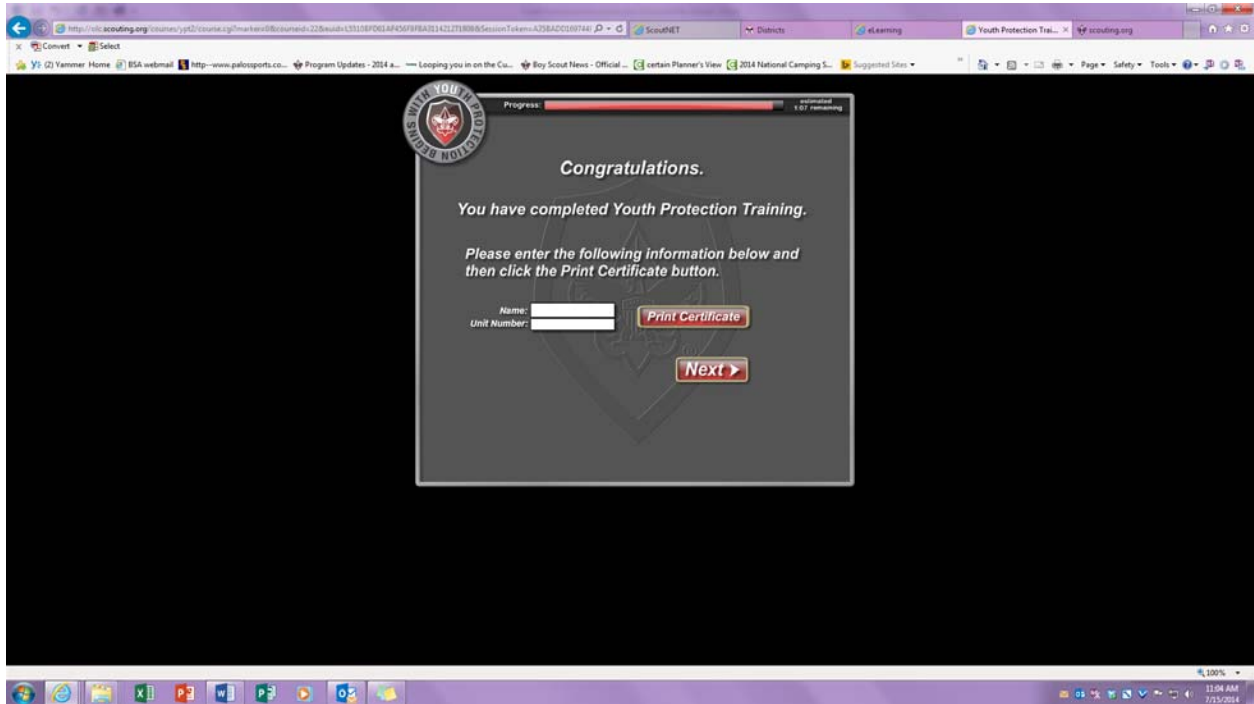
Once you have gotten to the end of the program, you will have an opportunity to download a letter from our Scout Executive that you can keep as a handy reference on reporting of Youth Protection issues. Simply select the **Atlanta Area Council -092** and print out the letter. Click **Next** when done.



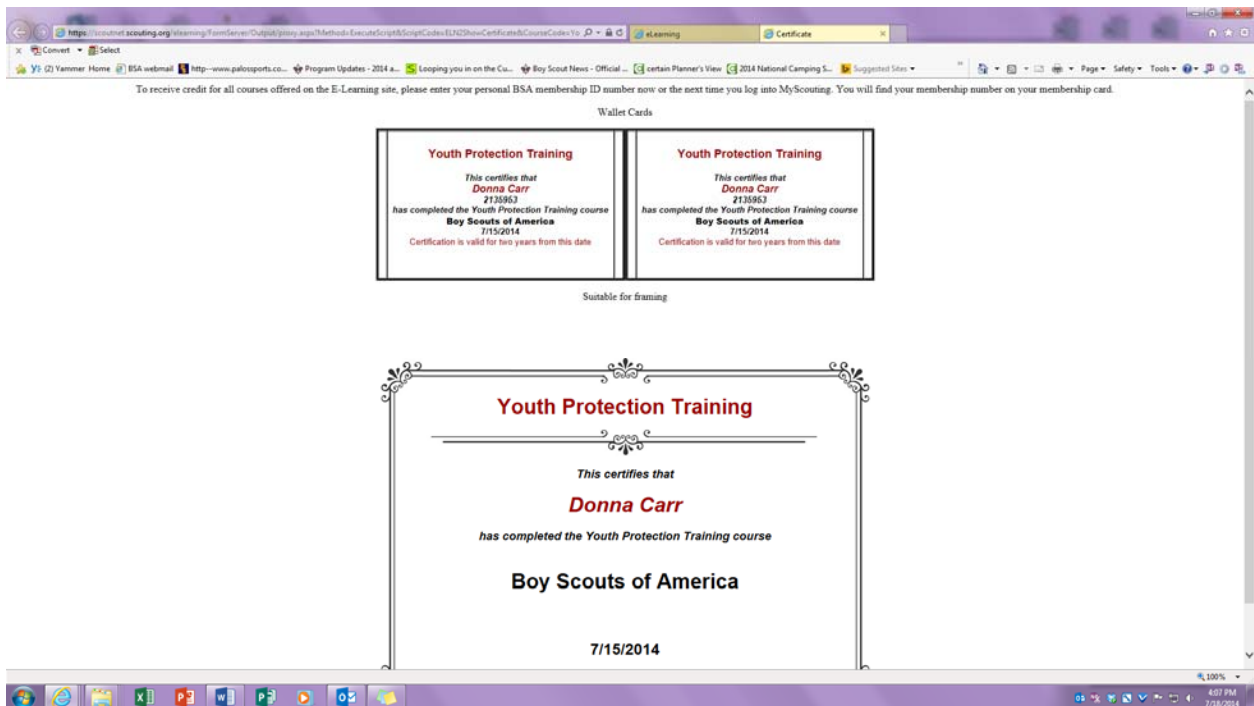
This is a sample of what the Scout Executive letter should look like.



Once you have completed the entire session, be sure to print out your certificate! **Put your name in the Name box and your unit type (Pack, Troop, Crew, Team, etc) and number in the Unit Number box** before pressing the **Print Certificate** button.
