What Makes a Trained Leader?



Leaders are considered trained once complete with **Youth Protection Training (YPT-2)** **and** the required courses listed in the boxes below.

Direct Contact Leaders (SMs, ASMs, Cubmasters, Den Leaders, Advisors) must also take **Weather Hazards Training** (on-line).

Once trained, adult leaders may wear the official *Trained* emblem on the left sleeve. *If an adult leader changes leadership position, the leader shall take the training for the new position to continue to wear the trained strip.*

All leaders must retake new **Youth Protection Training 2 [YPT 2]** before 9/30/18.

Required Training:

ALL LEADERS

Youth Protection Training (YPT-2)

Required for all adults. **All currently registered adults must ensure they take Youth Protection Training 2 (YPT 2) before 9/30/2018.** Each adult must take YPT 2 at least every two years to stay current.

BSA SCOUT LEADERS

• SMs and ASMs

1. Troop Leader
2. Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)
3. Weather Hazards

• Committee Members: Troop Committee Challenge

VENTURING LEADERS

Advisors & Committees (VLST) and Youth (VLSC)

1. Venturing Leader-Specific Training
2. Weather Hazards

CUB SCOUT LEADERS

Specific training for every Cub Scouting role is offered. If a change in leadership position occurs, the leader must take the training for the new position to continue to wear the trained strip.

- **Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear & Webelos Den Leaders:** Den Leader Position-Specific Training, Weather Hazards
- **Cubmaster and Assistant Cubmaster:** Cubmaster Position-Specific Training, Weather Hazards
- **Pack Committee:** Pack Committee Position-Specific Training; this is also called Pack Committee Challenge
- **Pack Trainer:** Pack Committee Training as noted above plus shall take Fundamentals of Training
- **Cub Recruiting:** This course is for those responsible for doing fall recruiting & School night events. Some instructors offer a combined form for Den Leaders, Cubmasters, and Committee all in one course.
