## Required Training:

<p><b><u>ALL LEADERS</u></b>  <b>Youth Protection Training</b> is required for all registered adults. Must be retaken at least every 2 years.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>CUB SCOUT LEADERS</u></b></p> <p>Specific training for every Cub Scouting role is offered.
