



# Interpreter Strip



Youth and Adult members (Cub and Webelos Scouts, Boy and Varsity Scouts, and Venturers and Sea Scouts, plus Scouters in all programs) may wear this strip if they show their knowledge of a foreign language or the sign language for the hearing impaired by:

- Carrying on a 5-minute conversation in this language.
- Translating a 2-minute speech or address.
- Writing a letter in the language (Does not apply for sign language)
- Translating 200 words or more from the written word.
- This uniform insignia is worn centered above "Boy Scouts of America" strip
