STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The Atlanta Area Council is blessed to have three great camps that serve thousands of campers and attendees at day use activities each year. In 2009, our camps recorded over 115,000 camper nights. In a continued effort to meet the ever increasing demand for our properties, the council camping committee looked at facilities at our camps that might not have been available to our Scouts and Scouters' in the past.

The Council Camping Committee's purpose in implementing fees for use of council facilities is to expand the opportunity for council, district and unit activities to access facilities that normally would not be available them, while at the same time helping to defray the cost of supplies and maintenance on these select facilities. It is the consensus of the Camping Committee that any fees charged for use of council facilities is not to be for the purpose of raising funds for general use or future improvement. The goal is to help maintain facilities in good repair for use by the units and their members but also allow more access to facilities that may have not been available for use in the past.

We still want to insure that a unit can come to camp, set up their tents use the restrooms and access many common areas without any facility fees being assessed. Only if the unit/individual wishes to access a select facility/building, will there be any fee assessed.



What facilities/areas will NOT have a usage fee?

- All Campsites and any shelters within at all camps. Exception for Cub Adventure campsites
- 2. All common restrooms/shower houses including supplies for them
- 3. Campsite Pavilions @ WSR & BASR
- 4. Pavilions @ BASR (Arnold, Cherokee, Jamison West, Jamison East, Cub Adventure 1 & 2, Jamison Central, Aquatics, Toms Diner)
- 5. Pavilions @ WSR (Main, Handicraft, Provisional, Outdoor Skills 1 & 2, Aquatics,)
- 6. Pavilions at Camp Allatoona
- 7. Health Lodges @ both camps (district and council events)
- 8. Donnell Nature Center (WSR)
- 9. Items like the Rizor Porch (WSR) and any porch/shelter of any camp building
- 10. Shooting Sports Range Pavilions (when not in use by Shooting Sports activities)
- 11. Hiking Trails and Nature Trails
- 12. Activity Fields and Assembly Areas everywhere in our camps
- 13. Group Campfire Rings and Amphitheatres in all camps
- 14. Fishing at Bert Adams and Woodruff
- 15. Water in sites and common areas as well as trash removal from trash deposited at camp dumpsters
