

Scouts Got Talent Guidelines

To be Eligible:

- The show is open to all Scouts.
- Talents may include (but not limited to) singing, dancing, instrumental music, skits, magic, comedy, martial arts, juggling, NO LIP-SYNCHING.
- Everyone must return a completed and signed Scouts Got Talent Participation Form
- Scouts who are part of a group act should submit their Participation Forms together.
- Recommended length is 3 minutes; acts must be no more than 5 minutes.
- Maximum number of participants in an act is 8.
- In all cases, decisions of the judges are final and will not be open to discussion.
- Absolutely no profanity or insensitive subject matter will be permitted.
- Costumes must be appropriate for Scouting.
- Acts are responsible for their own props and costumes.
- All performances will be screened for appropriateness by the Scouts Got Talent Committee.
- If your act requires recorded accompanying music, the music must be: Provided to the Scouts Got Talent Committee no later than the week before the event. (Submit to SGTCommittee@gmail.com) The day of the event, CD must be labeled with Name of Act and Name of Music.
- It is the participant's responsibility to get the accompanying music back after the show.
- The top 3 acts will perform live at the arena show Saturday night.
- There will be prizes given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
