



## DRIVER'S GUIDE TO SCOUT CHALLENGE 2022

We're excited you're joining us – or at least dropping off Scouts – for this awesome event. We've included here some guidelines to help you understand the process of getting into Scout Challenge and getting your Scouts unloaded. It will evoke memories of the preschool drop off line during the first week of school, or even Chic-fil-A on a busy day. Please have patience and trust the process!

**PRO TIPS: DRIVERS WILL REMAIN IN THE CARS FOR THE ENTIRE PROCESS.  
CARS WILL UNLOAD IN CENTRAL AREAS.  
DIRECT CAMPSITE ACCESS IS NOT AVAILABLE TO VEHICLES.**

### BEFORE YOU LEAVE:

- Make sure you have a marker to fill out your dash card
- Make sure the Scouts in your car know what their troop number is
- Encourage Scouts to keep belongings packed and ready to unload for the car ride – unloading will go faster without a lot of little things to grab from the car.

### AS YOU PULL INTO THE GATES:

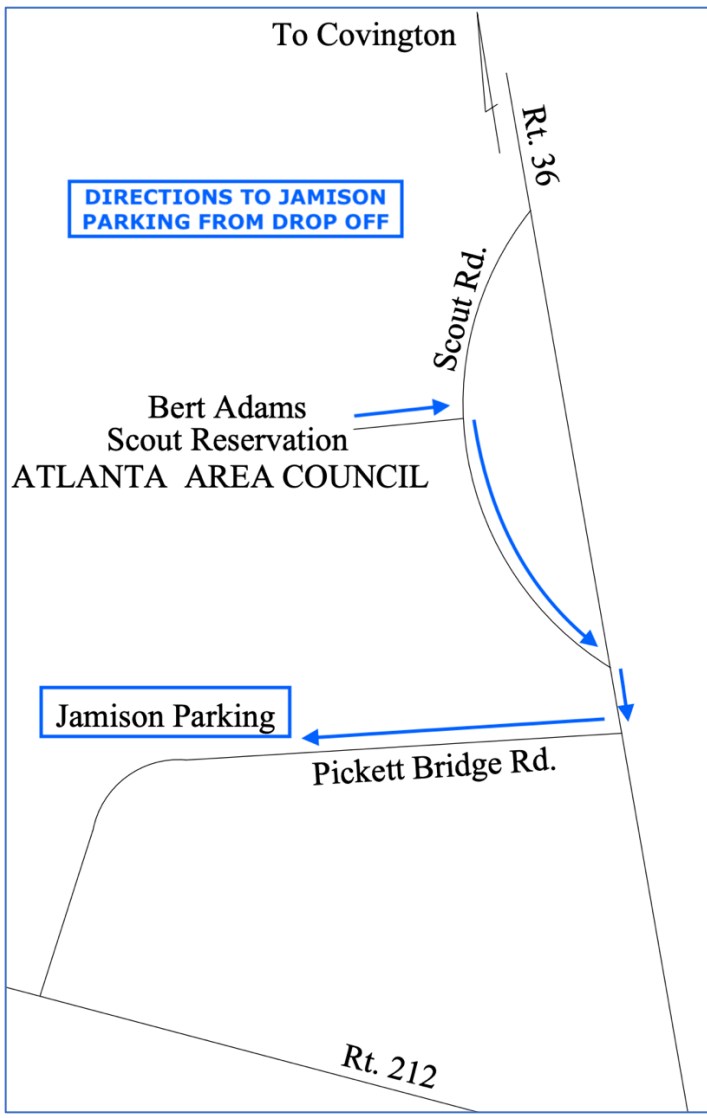
- You'll be greeted by a volunteer who will ask your Troop number and give you your dash card and instructions on where to proceed. Please immediately put the card on your dash.
- If your dash card is GREEN, you'll proceed to the EMERSON lot.
- If your dash card is PINK, you'll proceed to the GORMAN lot.
- Lighted signs will guide the way.
- Encourage Scouts to start gathering belongings while driving to the parking lot, and start to say your goodbyes if you're not staying.

### AS YOU PULL INTO THE LOT (here's where it feels like preschool carpool line):

- Please follow all instructions of the volunteer parking team.
- When you have followed the line into place, and the volunteers instruct, ALL passengers should very quickly unload all gear into the grass loading zone.
- Once all gear is cleared from the car, participants should step out of the lot and into the grass.
- When instructed, drivers should proceed out of the lot and head toward the camp exit to either go to the Jamison parking area or to leave camp.
- Passengers – Scouts and Adults – will be instructed on next steps for what to do while drivers move their cars.

### GETTING TO THE JAMISON LOT:

- You will actually exit the camp entirely to go to the Jamison lot.
- At the camp gate, you'll turn right onto Boy Scout Road and drive until it dead ends on Rt. 36.
- Turn Right on Rt. 36 and then turn right on Pickett Bridge Road (there's a small sign for Camp Jamison here).
- Proceed down Pickett Bridge Road until you come to the lot.
- It's further to the lot than you think down Pickett Bridge Road. We promise it's there.



### AT JAMISON LOT:

- Please follow all instructions of the volunteer parking team.
- Volunteers will direct you to a SPECIFIC SPOT to park.
- We have a spot just for you!
- Once you're parked, please make sure your information is on your dash card and that it can be seen through your window.
- Once you've got everything and your car is locked, head to the shuttle.

### THE SHUTTLE:

- The shuttle will take you from Jamison up the camp road to the lower end of the Gorman parking lot.
- If you're the Unit leader or designated adult, please head to the Ashley Building at the top of the lot to check in.
- If someone else is checking your unit in, you can go and find your Scouts in their campsite or at the drop off.
